- 1. This is intended to be a maximum of a four-year scholarship, <u>renewed annually</u>, provided the applicant meets and agrees to the following Terms and Conditions. A two-year Associates Degree will be considered IF there is a pathway to a four-year degree.
- 2. The four-year calendar begins the date of enrollment of the applicants Freshman year.
- 3. A minimum of a 3.0 grade point average, on a 4.0 system, is required for any science, technology, engineering, math or biology-based career plan, anything resulting in a Bachelor of Science (BS/BSc).

OR

A minimum of a 3.2 grade point average, based on a 4.0 system, is required for any art or language-based career plan, anything resulting in a Bachelor of Arts (BA).

Official university published grades are required before any renewal payment will be made. Applicant MUST submit grades before the beginning of the subsequent academic year.

- 4. A minimum of 12 credit hours per semester must be maintained every semester.
- 5. This scholarship will be \$1000 per scholastic year if the above minimum conditions are met. This scholarship is good for a maximum of four years and a maximum of \$4000.

#### 6. DEAL BREAKERS AND IMMEDIATE TERMINATION OF SCHOLARSHIP
